

PIP services offer specialist home interventions for disabled children aged 0-8 years with delays in their learning and development difficulties with communication, behaviour and sensory needs and where parents/carers need advice and support.

PlayWise provides bespoke services for children tailor-made to the child's needs, unique to the family situation, flexible and in line with everyday family life with a disabled child and within the EYFS framework as required.

PIP works in partnership with the family to deliver a home based intervention that is as unique as the child. We provide the appropriate teaching resources to ensure every child has full access to learning, regardless of their health needs, positioning requirements or developmental profile. We create a home learning package of support that fits your child and celebrates all successes.

PIP staff are matched to the child and family to ensure the best working relationship and long term/consistent support.

Hours can be increased flexibly - increasing in frequency rather than duration based on child's capacity and needs and can fit in and around hospital and consultant/medical appointments.

PlayWise recognises that parents are a child's best teacher and therefore we encourage parents and carers to play an active role in their child's learning and development.

PIP Services are hourly. This hour consists of 45 mins hands-on teaching/15 minutes note writing)
