By providing quality holistic services we help families to improve levels of parental confidence, increase levels of independence, reduce isolation, maximise learning potential and ultimately improve outcomes for children and families.

Visual strategies are an essential tool to assist speech, language and communication development as well as reduce anxiety and resistance to change. They support children to regulate behaviour, boost motivation and understanding and serve as a tool to manage with transitions - why would you not use them!

The aim for this workshop is to;

- Understand why and how visuals support communication and the role they play in language development.
- Assist you to implement a visual communication system at home or in your setting
- Raise awareness on the different types of visuals supports and when and how to use them

- Understanding the importance of Observation & Speculation

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












SIGNALONG WORKSHOP PHASE 1

- Develop strategies to create a supportive learning environment

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















SLEEP!!! WHAT'S THAT?

Sleep is an essential part of everyone's daily routine and strongly related to quality of life, learning, health and emotional well-being. Sleep, like diet and exercise, helps us to grow, recover from the wear and tear of daily life and build immunity. However up to 80% of children with developmental disabilities have disturbed sleep that affects their development, day time behaviour, learning and health.

This workshop is to help develop an understanding of the following:

- · Why is it essential to get good sleep (and what happens if we don't),
- · Why children with developmental disabilities have particular sleep challenges.
- What is good sleep hygiene and how to set up an effective sleep routine
- Managing sensory and difficult behaviour issues at bedtime
- Developing a range of tips and strategies to support a SEND child's sleep

- Seek specific information about a child's development/ home life from parents/ carers.

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
















SUPPORTING SEND **FAMILIES IN THE COMMUNITY**

For professionals only

This course covers a range of topics to provide a snapshot into what a parent might experience when having a child with a disability including, the number of appointments a parent/ child has, the number of professionals a child might have to see, the impact of receiving a diagnosis (including the stages of grief) and the impact on the wider family, stressors involved in raising a disabled child and how professionals can help.

The aim of the workshop

- · To raise awareness to professionals and provide an insight into what the parents lived experiences are of having a child with a disability
- To understand how challenging medical appointments & hospital visits are and what it means to receive a diagnosis as well as what you can do to help
- How professionals can use local service to support families



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NATIONAL PORTAGE ASSOCIATION WORKSHOP

This workshop is suitable for anyone interested in finding out more about the Portage model and how to support children's development and learning and could include Early Years Practitioners, Teachers, therapists, and parents. The course is delivered by National Portage Association Accredited Trainers.

This 2.5 day workshop is practical and hands on and aims to give participants:

- An understanding of Portage Principles and the Portage model of support
- How to support children's learning, using the Portage approach
- The theory of Portage Practice

- The importance of using clear language and how to plan successful outcomes and set long term aims.
- How to use a small steps approach in teaching children new skills through play
- Approaches to help children generalise skills
- Basic appropriate responses and approaches to address behaviour

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



*TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BOOKING OF TRAINING COURSES/ WORKSHOPS:

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On receipt of a course booking from a school, or local authority organisation an invoice will be raised. The invoice is due for payment before the course date except when the booking is made less than 14 days before the course date. For bookings made less than 14 days before the date of the course, payment should be made no later than 14 days after the course.

For bookings from private organisations/ individuals (unless they already have an established account with PlayWise Learning CIC), a link for online payment will be sent and payment will be required in advance. Once payment has been received, their booking will be confirmed and attendance approved on the course/ workshop.

Payment for attendance at a workshop/ course should be made within 14 days of receiving an invoice, which will be raised on receipt of booking. If the event is less than 14 days away, then payment must be made immediately on invoice.

The only exception to this is by prior arrangement, where we would require an official purchase order to confirm the place. Purchase orders may be accepted in lieu of payment, at time of booking, at PlayWise Learning CIC's sole discretion.

There are circumstances where an event has to be cancelled or a date changed. We will endeavour to notify booked delegates of any cancellations or changes at the earliest opportunity. There may be some circumstances, however, where it is only possible to offer shorter notice of cancellation (e.g. trainer illness or emergency) Where a course has been cancelled or postponed we will offer delegates alternative dates. If the delegate is unable to attend any of the alternative dates, a full refund will be aiven.

PlayWise Learning CIC shall not accept liability for any consequential loss and shall have no liability to reimburse any other costs that might be incurred staff cover.

If a booked delegate wishes to cancel their attendance at an event, the rebates below will apply. If the delegate has yet to pay the fee, this will still remain due to PlayWise Learning CIC, less the rebate figure stated below. Cancellation should be made in writing via email to: info@playwise.org.uk Calendar Days Prior to Event Rebate Rate - 30 days or more 100% - 15-29 days 50% - 0-14 days 0% Substitution of delegates can be made at any time free of charge.
