

PASC Group: PlayWise Play & Social Communication Skills Group:

For children with social communication
difficulties & their parent

What is PASC?

(This is a referral only group)

This group is a 10 week interactive learning programme for children experiencing a delay in social, play and communication skills. The group aims to develop a parent's knowledge and use of strategies, for encouraging interaction and communication, listening, visual cueing and routine through modelling and practice.

How does PASC work?

Each small group session is structured with a fun and predictable routine to encourage a child's emerging language and play skills. A range of new experiences are introduced to the children in a gentle and repetitive way to develop confidence and teach new skills. Activities include circle time, story massage, group story, social snack time and table top based attention activities. Parents are supported to be actively involved in their child's learning and are introduced to a range of early play and communication strategies to further support their child's development at home.
